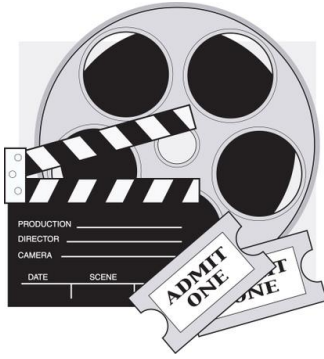


MOVIE CLUB
