1. **Cave Springs Camp** - a report about the complete cancellation of the 2020 camping season and the continuing maintenance expenses is of concern. We will look into possible contributions to Cave Springs. The congregation will receive this report along with this Sunday's e-bulletin.
2. **Migrant Farmworkers Project** - There is not a lot of work happening right now according to Caron Edwards. Certain volunteers have kept in touch by telephone and delivered food parcels or cooked meals to the households which the project normally serves. We decided to send a donation of \$300, in lieu of the dinner we normally serve, to facilitate the caring gifts of food.
3. **Case for Kids** - This year the fundraising is solely online. Dayle has registered a 'team' for Trinity Grimsby and a request for donations has appeared in the past 2 bulletins. Funds are coming in but continued efforts are needed to get Trinity up to our usual goal of \$1000.
4. **Traditional Recipients** - we will request Blue Envelope donations of \$300 each be made to Habitat for Humanity Niagara and Angola Memorial Scholarship Fund.
5. **Black Lives Matter Movement** - We acknowledge the impact on our world and on every person as a result of the Black Lives Matter movement. We will prayerfully consider specific actions that promote inclusivity and equity both in our church community and the wider community. Thank you Rev. Donalee for your eloquent service this past Sunday addressing this issue.
